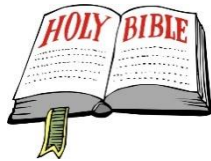

## **First Aid Kit**

**Romans 4:5** To the man who does **not work** but trusts God who justifies the **wicked**, his faith is credited as righteousness. (Though we do nothing to deserve a reward, but instead are wicked, God has declared us to be righteous anyway. The good news is outrageous forgiveness to undeserving sinners.)

**Romans 3:21** But now a righteousness from God, **apart from law**, has been made known, to which the Law and the Prophets testify. **22**-This righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. (Your righteousness has come from God and his perfection, not from your ability to follow the law. This righteousness comes to us merely by trusting that he has done it.)

**Romans 3:22B** There is no difference, **23**-for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, **24**-and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.

**1 John 2:1** My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have one who speaks to the Father in our defense—Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. (You have a lawyer who has never lost a case and he will certainly win yours.)

**Job 16:19** Even now my witness is in heaven; my advocate is on high. **20**-My intercessor is my friend as my eyes pour out tears to God; **21** on behalf of a man he pleads with God as a man pleads for his friend.

**Hebrews 4:15** For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. **16**-Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

**John 5:24** “I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me **has** eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life.”

**1John2:2** He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world.

**John 11:25** Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies”

**Job 19:25** I know that my Redeemer lives, and that in the end he will stand upon the earth. **26**-And after my skin has been destroyed, yet in my flesh I will see God; **27**-I myself will see him with my own eyes—I, and not another. How my heart yearns within me!

**Luke 23:42** "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." **43**-Jesus answered him, "I tell you the truth, today you will be with me in paradise."

**Galatians 3:27** for all of you who were baptized into Christ are clothed with Christ. (If you are clothed with Christ then you will certainly be standing before the throne on the last day.)

**Ephesians 5:25** "...Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her **26**-to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, **27**-and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless." (You have been cleansed by the washing with water through the word. You are therefore holy and blameless in Jesus.)

**John 6:54** "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood **has** eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. **55**-For my flesh is real food and my blood is real drink."

**Romans 10:9** If you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

**Romans 10:11** The Scripture says, "WHOEVER BELIEVES IN HIM WILL NOT BE DISAPPOINTED."

**2 Corinthians 5:19** God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of reconciliation. (The world stands reconciled now.)

**Hebrews 2:15** (Jesus came to) free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death.
